Re-roofing 101



Before:

The roof on this home is over 25 years old. There are two layers of shingles under the top layer. The existing shingles are showing signs of clawing (turning under) and there is some leakage around the flashing.



Step 1: Tear-off

The existing shingles are removed and disposed of. Tarps and plywood are used to protect the landscaping around the house.



Step 2: Bare Roof

This is our opportunity to inspect the roof deck. We will correct any carpentry issues, add ventilation if necessary, and prepare the building for a new roof.



Step 3: Prep Work

The replacement process begins with edging, Ice and Water Shield, GAF Deck Armour and valleys. Chimneys and other projections are prepared for flashing.



Step 4: Shingling

In this example, our trained professionals carefully installed new GAF HD Barkwood shingles according to the manufacturer's instructions.



Step 5: Project Completion

The dumpster is removed, the driveway and sidewalks are swept and the job is inspected by a member of the L.H. Krueger and Son staff.
